Racism is best characterized as an especially pernicious form of inapt contempt, and Bell's account of contempt helps us better understand the moral

badness of racism. It is argued that the best way of responding to race-based contempt is to mobilize a robust counter-contempt for racists. The book concludes with a discussion of overcoming contempt through forgiveness.
